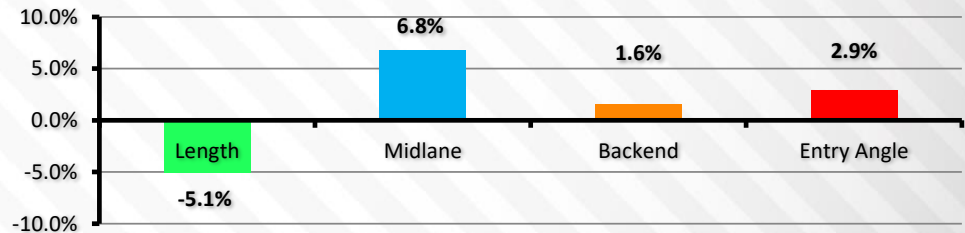

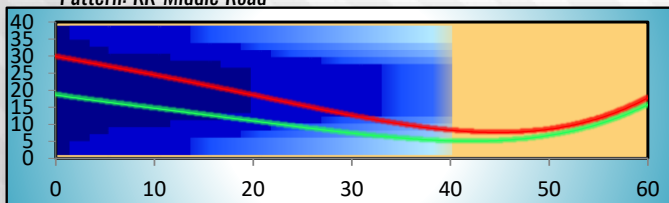

- NRG Solid was notably earlier reading than NRG Smooth Pearl.
- The Centripetal Core was strong and even rolling for both balls.
- Both balls complimented each other exceptionally well.
